AFFORDABILITY



Homeownership is within reach – US News & World Report recently named St. Louis among the top 25 most affordable cities in the United States. St. Louis has the second highest rate of millennial home ownership. And the St. Louis Fed has the data that shows our standard of living is higher than 94 percent of the MSAs (Metropolitan Statistical Areas) in the nation.

TECHNOLOGY & INNOVATION



St. Louis was recently named a "Rising Star" for tech by the Brookings Institute. The Kauffman Index said we saw the largest upward shift of startup activity in the country in 2017. Home to more than 700 life sciences and agtech firms, the St. Louis agtech sector has been hailed by the Brookings Institution as a model for the nation. And we're expanding our geospatial industry, led by a new National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency West HQ (a \$1.75B facility).
